In Coding IxD, we co-educate computer scientists and product designers. Beyond experiencing interdisciplinary work, we want students to envision novel interaction concepts. For this, we teach and engage students to carefully embrace code, material, and form by respecting human capabilities and vulnerabilities.

We see Coding IxD as an experimental space in which different perspectives can be developed, exchanged, and critically reflected upon. This semester, students worked in project teams to explore the diversity of human body data. In this context, the teams delved into the lived embodiments of individuals and groups to explore how their unique experiences can shape lives differently.
